The following items will be addressed on the call:

- 4.5% permanent rate increases
- 10% temporary rate increase for nine months
- Funding to assist providers in establishing new pensions or benefits in the next state fiscal year
- Grants for homes with issued rates lower than calculated rates
- Funding for new social work staffing ratio requirements that are effective no earlier than 1/1/22
- Transition to an acuity based rate system in July 2022
- New CON review process for substantial bed reduction
